## Our welcome to Saint John Bosco

Waiting for the forthcoming bi-centenary of Saint Don Bosco's birth in 2015, a casket with his relics is currently on a pilgrimage throughout the world.

It is meant to be a the-other-way-round pilgrimage: followers usually visit churches and holy places. This time it is Saint Don Bosco to go and visit people everywhere in the world.

The pilgrimage began on 31st January 2009, another important anniversary for the Salesians as it was 150 years from the foundation of the Congregation itself.

It was Thursday 21th November when the relics landed at Venice International Airport and soon moved to Collegio Astori in Mogliano Veneto. For those of you that are acquainted with TGS Eurogroup, this place is expected to sound familiar: indeed it is our headquarter in Italy and the same place where we meet your leaders and students.

The relics of Don Bosco have been recomposed from the urn that contained his remains since 1929 when the body was exhumed.

Later on he was declared Blessed and canonised on Easter Sunday in 1934.

The urn consists of a large glass box in which the wax replica is placed and easily viewed.

Among the urn's decorations are the words "Da mihi animas, ceatera tolle", which translates to "Give me souls, take away everything else", one of Don Bosco's many quotes.

The main celebration took place the day after the relics' arrival in Venice and gathered together people of all ages raging from children, families and adults.

TGS representatives were there to welcome the urn: it was a good chance for our students and leaders to attend and help during the Mass.

This collaboration allowed to show the awareness of Don Bosco's spirituality and the importance of young people in the Church.
